The trips have helped to improve overall fitness, balance, strength, body control and flexibility whilst introducing the children to a professional sport that is not normally available to them. The trip was very popular with the children and staff. Staff have said what a great opportunity it is for the children to try new equipment and take risks in a safe environment that they wouldn't normal experience and the freedom to explore large areas. Professional coaches will coach all pupils and staff in a range of specialist's sports. The funding will allow pupils to practise new physically challenging sport that is not normally available to them and meet the curriculum 14 additional P.E subject areas.
